Case History:

This 57-year-old male patient was admitted with a history of pain in the Right Hypochondrium 8 to 10 months back with a repeat episode of pain 20 days back. There were no other associated features. Investigations revealed Cholelithiasis and Chronic Cholecystitis. Patient was posted for Laparoscopic Cholecystectomy on 28/12/2010. Incidental finding intraoperatively was Cholecystoduodenal Fistula and Gallbladder adhesions of Cholecystoduodenal fixation was done in 2 layers. Laparoscopic Cholecystectomy with Laparoscopic repairing Post operative period was uneventful. Stitches and drain have been removed. Patient recovered satisfactorily fixation was done in 2 layers.
