Case History:

This 6-month-old female baby was admitted with a swelling over the Lumbosacral region and increasing head circumference since birth. On examination, she was noted to have Myelomeningocele with Hydrocephalus, Flaccid Paralysis of lower limbs and Talipes Equinovarus. On admission, baby was started on I.V. antibiotics and blood examinations were done as per protocol. A plan for VP shunt with repair of Myelomeningocele was taken. VP shunt was done under General Anesthesia by medium pressure Chhalosa Shunt and repair of Myelomeningocele were done under General Anesthesia on 12/11/10. Postoperative period was uneventful. Baby received I.V. antibiotics for 14 days. She is being discharged in relatively stable haemodynamic condition.
